Dear Members of the Assembly,

In May, Executive Board (EB) finished training at the end of May. EB had its first meeting on May 31 where we opened and closed seats for EB seats on committees. We have filled all the EB seats for these committees. EB has since received and approved reports and year plans from Diversity + Equity Network, EFRT, Macademics, Spark, FCC, Maroons, SHEC, and SWHAT. Both the reports and year plans were well done.

SWHAT proposed changes to the SWHAT Operating Policy to remove the Special Projects Coordinator as a required executive position for the service. They proposed the change to reflect the current state of the executive team as this position has not been filled for the past few years and the lack of this position has not affected the functioning of the service. EB approved proposed changes.

SWHAT also proposed changes to the SWHAT Dispatcher Job Description to change the hour requirements from four hours a week to three to six hours a week and to no longer require previous SWHAT experience. They proposed the changes to reflect SWHAT's current operations and to increase Dispatcher applications. EB approved proposed changes.

Current Challenges

Participation in EB has been a bit low but we are hoping that it will increase once there are more agenda items that will drive discussion.
