To the Members of the Assembly,

Last week, the Executive Board held a meeting pertaining to a wide variety of things which the Members of the SRA may or may not find of interest but are such as follows:

- EFRT and SWHAT presented their services reports.
 - o The general concerns of the two groups was that there was a slight delay on their operations due to the inability to spend money because of the SRA budget approval issue. There was no stated expectation of long-term impact.
 - o Additionally, SWHAT was having some issues with finding a place for their events, a number of suggestions was fielded by the Board.
- The seats on the Sponsorship and Donations committee have been unable to be closed due to a continued absence of an application of an MSU member to join.
- A number of motions passed unopposed regarding the updating of the food collection center roles and bylaws.
 - o This mostly pertained to the Meal Exchange Program discontinuing its McMaster chapter so that needing to be removed from the bylaws. While also adding the community fridge to the bylaws in addition to a new job posting for the oversight of the program.
- There was an announcement from the AVP services of which services would be reviewed in the coming year. It was noted that 4 of 5 services that President Singh had recommended to be reviewed will be.
 - o No opposition to the selection
