Progress on Yearplan

- Sustainability & Education in Residence:
 - o Set up meeting with Manager of Residence Building Operations (Sept. 28) regarding organic waste disposal
 - o Had meeting with Living & Learning Coordinator/Sustainability & Wellness Co-Chair in Residence regarding the implementation of sustainability education materials in residence
- Increased Engagement:
 - o Currently collaborating with the McMaster Humanities Society (MHS) to start hosting SRA content on the MHS website for better visibility to the Humanities student population
 - o Connected with Humanities reps and the MHS at Faculty Fest to promote the SRA by-election in October, continuing to collaborate for social media promotion closer to the date
- Echo360 Audit
 - o Continuing the initiative started by last year's University Affairs committee to send a survey out to faculty members to assess challenges with implementing Echo360 in their classes

Upcoming Events, Projects, & Activities

- Looking to complete class talks within the Faculty of Humanities once other caucus members are elected
- Continued growth of social media presence
- Development of a feedback form to be distributed to Humanities students
