To the members of the Assembly,

For the past few weeks, Executive Board has listened to insightful reports from services including Emergency First Response Team (EFRT), Food Collective Centre (FCC), Diversity + Equity Network (DEN), First Year Council (FYC), Macademics, Maccess, Maroons, Pride Community Centre (PCC), Student Health Education Centre (SHEC), Student Walk Home Attendant Team (SWHAT), and Women + Gender Equity Network (WGEN).

The Diversity + Equity Network requested the addition of a Peer Support Coordinator role so that the service could fully transition into a Peer Support Service. This job description was approved by the Executive Board.

The Executive Board also approved the Maccess year plan and closed the seat for the Wage Review Committee.

EFRT has requested an extended closure, past the typical Reading Week closure and until Thursday, October 20th. This is due to a high volume of calls since the beginning of the term and fears of burnout within the team. Executive Board approved the closure and further extended it until Saturday, October 22nd. There are hopes to work on structural and long-term solutions to EFRT's high workload and volume of hours.

Current Challenges

Some current challenges include getting more participation in MSU led events and initiatives and keeping the required number of SRA seats on Executive Board.
