Progress on Year Plan

The Internal Governance Committee has begun our activities for the fall term, with an emphasis placed on introductions to the committee's work and MSU policy. Furthermore, we have begun laying the groundwork for what we hope will be a successful and productive year.

Past Events, Projects, & Activities

Policy Review Schedule:

- There are 15 policies scheduled for review this year, with the oldest having been reviewed 8 years ago. These policies have been organized into a month-by-month breakdown and divided between committee members.

Continuing Previous Work

- The fall term will also focus on continuing work started by the preceding AVP and wrapping up any past projects.
- These projects include revisions to Bylaw 6 (General Assembly), as well as the Promotions and Advertising and MSU Governance and You policies.

In recent years, there has been some concern regarding the number of policies scheduled for the committee to review. By assigning a monthly schedule and delegating leadership of the review process to committee members, we are hopeful that the committee will be able to adhere to the review as scheduled by Graeme.
