Dear Members of the Assembly,

Since the last SRA meeting, we had one executive board meeting. We initially had two scheduled but due to scheduling conflicts, the agenda items from our meeting will be pushed to the upcoming executive board meeting. We approved minutes from EB 22-14 – October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

We received reports from PCC, Diversity + Equity Network, EFRT, and FCC. PCC has been seeing an uptick with general space usage and students coming in to access lounge space and casual support. Diversity + Equity Network saw similar trends with an increase of service usage and are currently finalizing their peer support coordinator. EFRT has now had a total of 305 calls since August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and have been concerns rising with students neglecting basic food/water/sleep needs. FCC is on track with their year plan and has recently opened up their food bank space in the basement of the Refectory building (available between 10:30AM-2:30PM). Overall, general services usage is on the uptick.

Executive Board has also granted Key Access to the Committee Room to the Spark Sessions Coordinators (Executives) to carry out the responsibilities within their purview.
