

Operating Policy – MSU Students of Distinction Award

- 1. Criteria for Granting the MSU Students of Distinction Award
 - 1.1 The MSU Students of Distinction Award shall be granted in recognition of internal and external individuals or groups who have made a significant contribution to the betterment of the MSU or student life at McMaster.
 - 1.1.1 The nomination should reflect at least two (2) of the following attributes to be considered for the award:
 - 1.1.1.1 Advocacy;
 - 1.1.1.2 Collaboration;
 - 1.1.1.3 Conscientiousness:
 - 1.1.1.4 Innovation:
 - 1.1.1.5 Leadership.
 - 1.2 There shall be no limit to the number of these awards granted each year.
 - 1.3 Award recipients shall receive an MSU insignia pin in addition to a Certification of Appreciation.
 - 1.3.1 Only one pin and one certificate shall be granted beyond the first award:
 - 1.3.2 In the event that the pin is lost, a new pin may be obtained for a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00).

Procedure

- 2.1 The Executive Board shall, through the Office of the MSU President, arrange for the public announcement of a call for nominations through local and campus media.
 - 2.1.1 Applications for the award shall be accepted via:
 - 2.1.1.1 In person at the MSU Main Office;
 - 2.1.1.1.1 The application shall be placed in a sealed envelope addressed to the MSU President,

Approved 03D Revised 04F, 07P, 09Q, 22J bearing the nominee's name and the name of the award.

2.1.1.2 Email to the MSU President;

- 2.1.1.2.1 The application should be attached to the email, with the subject line "Students of Distinction Award (Nominee's name)".
- 2.2 The Executive Board shall determine the MSU Students of Distinction Award recipient(s) according to the criteria for granting the award.
 - 2.2.1 Deliberations shall be held in closed session during an Executive Board meeting and the recipient(s) shall be determined by a twothirds affirmative vote.
- 2.3 The recipient(s) of the MSU Students of Distinction Award shall be contacted by the President, and arrangements shall be made for the public announcement of the recipient(s) through on-campus media at the end of the month. The President shall present the MSU insignia pin and Certificate of Appreciation to the award recipient(s).
