# **Yearplan Update**

EFRT is on track as per the year plan. The executive team is functioning well, convocation is steadily underway, and we are currently planning for our first summer monthly training. Due to extra time and willingness to move forward the executive team and myself are planning future events currently.

# **Events, Projects, & Activities**

### General Service Usage

EFRT Summer operations began May 15 at 0900h. We operate from 0900h to 1700h Monday to Friday until August 25th. Typical summer usage is significantly decreased as compared to the school year. However, it is notable that EFRT has received ~20 calls from the beginning of our summer operations. Interestingly, current trends suggest that most of these calls consist of upgrading patients to requiring activation of EMS.

#### Projects & Events:

#### Exec Hiring and Onboarding (Complete)

EFRT has hired all 5 executives and they have all received their transition. The executives are completing their tasks as per their JDs. Currently the executive team has had 3 formal meetings.

#### Resource Inventory (Complete)

The executive team spent ~7 hours to completely organize and inventory all EFRT equipment. This is a necessary task as the data from inventory determines how much equipment EFRT will be purchasing.

#### EFRT Summer Operations (Ongoing)

EFRT is responding during the summer months from May 15th – August 265h from 0900h to 1700h Monday to Friday. This response program will provide confidential medical support to the campus during the summer months. There will

be a series of trainings, practice scenarios, and collaborations with EFRT Alumni to maintain EFRT skills over the summer and ensure that the EFRT is available for events on campus and summer camps. There are no funding or logistical issues and everything is running smoothly.

#### EFRT SFA+CPR C and BLS Courses (Ongoing)

EFRT is providing Standard First Aid and Basic Life Support classes to the McMaster Community and the public. These courses are running smoothly thanks to the Assisstant Director and accounting office in the MSU. Courses for the summer are currently set to run on June 24-25, July 8-9, and July 22-23.

EFRT has been posting SFA courses on our Instagram as a primary means of attracting students and others to gain valuable first aid knowledge.




#### Social Media Engagement since the Previous Report

We currently do not have data to compare to. Below are current analytics from EFRTs Facebook page.


