Year plan Update

EFRT is on track as per the year plan. The executive team is functioning well with frequent meetings and most recently participating in a debrief to constructively review our communication and operating's for the last 4 months. Executives have completed their specialized retraining which ensures they will be able to support patients and Responders. A new protocol manual has also been released which aims to improve the quality-of-care EFRT Responders can deliver to patients.

EFRT is also preparing for its one of its most busy times of year. We are preparing for team-retraining which is taking place in a few short days, assisting with Rep training hosted by McMaster university, preparing for an extremely high call volume over the next month but especially during welcome week. Applications for this year's hiring cycle have also been released.

Events, Projects, & Activities

General Service Usage

EFRT Summer operations began May 15 at 0900h. We operate from 0900h to 1700h Monday to Friday until August 25th. Typical summer usage is significantly decreased as compared to the school year. However, it is notable that EFRT has received ~56 calls from the beginning of our summer operations. Interestingly, current trends suggest that most of these calls consist of upgrading patients to requiring activation of EMS.

Projects & Events:

Protocol Review (Complete)

EFRT completes a protocol review to ensure all information is up-to-date. This year the Program Director completed a complete restructuring of the protocol based on team and alumni recommendations. The manual was carefully crafted to contain the same information but in new format.

PTM Collab Magnets (Complete)

EFRT has collaborating with SWHAT and has covered the cost to produce welcome week magnets that highlight both services and will be given in "swag bags" throughout welcome week. Both services are similar and pivotal to the McMaster Student experience so we are excited to see the magnets in use.

EFRT Executive Retraining (Complete)

All EFRT year-exec complete a specialized training with the support of Executive Alumni in order to prepare Executives with their new leadership position and also to prepare them for executive, shift-specific actions.

EFRT Summer Operations (Ongoing)

EFRT is responding during the summer months from May 15th – August 265h from 0900h to 1700h Monday to Friday. This response program will provide confidential medical support to the campus during the summer months. There will be a series of trainings, practice scenarios, and collaborations with EFRT Alumni to maintain EFRT skills over the summer and ensure that the EFRT is available for events on campus and summer camps. There are no funding or logistical issues, and everything is running smoothly.


Promotional Materials

Executives & Volunteers

Current morale is at a high. Responders are happy to be back responding and are excited for welcome week. Despite it being an extremely busy and tiring time, responding to these calls is something the team truly enjoys and it tends to the highlight of the year! The executive team is excited to return to in-person meetings and to put much of the planning this past summer has been into action.

Successes

EFRT has updated the protocol manual which has not seen major restructuring since 2012. The manual includes gender affirming healthcare which was introduced last year, and also sets the framework for other protocols for Special Populations as EFRT grows and expands.

EFRT is also maintaining an excellent working relationship with the special constables which is not only positive in an interpersonal level but ensures that patients receive the highest quality care. Constables have also stated that they are looking forward to EFRT's return to 24/7 operations.

Current Challenges

There are currently no glaring challenges within EFRT now. My main concern at the moment is ensuring that the high call volume expected with Welcome Week is met with high patient care. This means keeping a close eye on equipment inventory as well as Responder wellness. Based on recommendation from Security EFRT has been requested to be staffed at Event Response capacities on Sept 16 and Sept 30th. These dates are coinciding with busy times of EFRT hiring specifically Sept 30th. The executive team is proactively searching for solutions and will be reaching out to the MSU and EFRT alumni for support as required.
