The start of school has been very productive for the education team, and the PFA committee is starting to get rolling. Most of our work so far has been writing and reviewing policy, so I'd like to excuse this report for those not interested in that.

OUSA

One of the main partners in the PFA department is the Ontario Undergraduate Student Alliance. Part of our responsibility at McMaster is to author policy papers that will be used to lobby the provincial government. This year the education team is working on two papers, one surrounding student wellness, and one regarding racial & religious discrimination. We had a thinktank/planning session with a group from OUSA where we discussed our feedback & edits for the race & religious discrimination paper. This was a long meeting, but also very productive. Since then, we have made further edits and updates to reflect current students' needs. On that note, we have also been doing edits on the student wellness paper.

We have also been working to begin the hiring process for our OUSA delegates. This year's fall GA will be held at Laurier. The MSU consistently runs a hiring process for delegates, that way we can have new faces and ensure the best delegates attend these conferences. We will be promoting this role by advertising this in big lecture halls to every year & diverse programs. If you happen to see us, please don't laugh too hard.

Year Plan

As we come into the new year, we are working to establish our priorities as AVPs, as well as within our committee. We held a thinktank session within the education team to see where our goals overlap, and how we can utilize that to advocate on behalf of students.
