Year Plan Update

EFRT is on track as per the year plan. The executive team is meeting frequently to maintain ensure that the new hires have a smooth transition to the team. Major trainings have been completed and future projects are simple and logistically simple.

Events, Projects, & Activities

General Service Usage

EFRT call volume thus far has been high and specific statistics will be compiled and shared soon. Call volume has been primarily consisting of medical emergencies and less trauma calls. Mental health calls have been steadily increasing.

Projects & Events:

EFRT First Responder [FR] Training (Complete)

New responders have completed their FR training on October 21,22 and October 28,29. The trained serves a legal and clinical guideline for responders. New responders are now permitted to run shifts.

Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support Training [PHTLS] Training (Complete)

The entire team (except the new cohort) received the PHTLS training. Instructors came from Georgian College and were all paramedic instructors. Further, the instructors had a high degree of professional experience in the field of prehospital medicine. This training was the first of its kind in 6 years and Responders reported that it contributed to a stronger understanding of the trauma framework and strengthened skills including but not limited to massive hemorrhage control, spinal motion restriction, and airway management.

Mental Health First Aid [MHFA] Training (Completed)

MHFA training was provided to the new cohort of responders and is a training offered by the Red Cross that aims to provide participations with a framework to support patients suffering with mental health crisis. Specifically, the training provides participants with knowledge about mental health conditions and the

background behind how crisis comes to be. It also provides a framework for how to assess a crisis and provide initial support. The training was provided through a mental health nurse at the Student Wellness Centre who was an ideal instructor due to their lived experience in crisis intervention. I was informed that the training was successful in its learning outcomes and that new responders feel more comfortable with mental health topics than before the training. In the coming years, EFRT is looking to provide responders in their first year on the team with MHFA and responders in their second year with ASSIST training. This training model has been theorized to be the most conducive to supporting our patients and responders through mental health calls.

EFRT SFA+CPR C and BLS Courses (Ongoing)

EFRT is providing Standard First Aid and Basic Life Support classes to the McMaster Community and the public. These courses are running smoothly thanks to the Assistant Director and accounting office in the MSU. The upcoming course is taking place November 18-19 with future courses being planned and will be released soon.

EFRT Uniform Order (Ongoing)

The uniform order is underway. The order details including financials and quantities have been finalized and the order has been placed. The uniform pant initiative is still underway however conversation with the supplier has slowed down due to employee constraints on their end. As a reminder the uniform pant initiative is to increase the uniform budget line to accommodate 1 pair of uniform pants. In addition to protecting responders from contamination when on call, the pants will contribute to an EFRT uniform which will match the professionalism of the service. A memo will be completed and submitted to the SRA to request an increase in funding upon finalized conversation with the supplier about fiscal details.

EFRT N95 Fit Test (Ongoing)

The N95 fit test must be completed by all EFRT responders a minimum of every 2 years. The fit test is organized by the Training Coordinator in collaboration with EOHSS. N95s serve keep responder safe from COVID-19, meningitis, arterial bleeds, etc.

EFRT Bonding Event (Ongoing)

Through the efforts of the Internal Coordinator, it has been recognized that the team is interested in a bonding event in the coming week that will be either bowling or laser tag. This bonding event serves to support volunteers and bolster a sense of community. I also hope that the bonding event will allow responders a chance to wind down and serve as burnout prevention as we enter exam season. I am looking into subsidizing the event through our volunteer appreciation line.

Outreach & Promotions

Summary

EFRT has begun to have biweekly PR booths outside of our office with the most recent booth being held last week. The booths span a total of 3 hours and our newest responders run them with the support of the PR Coordinator. PR materials were handed out and the student population were able to interact with responders. The focus of the booths are to informe the public of EFRTs role on campus and how to activate EFRT.


Promotional Materials

There are currently no major challenges within EFRT now. The main tasks moving forward are to support the new hires in their transition to responding to real patients rather than simulations. Further, supporting the team and protecting them from burnout is at the forefront of my initiatives.
