


Voter Turnout

Nominations Promotion

For November By-Elections, we had 3 rounds of nominations. SRA Engineering and Science caucuses were both filled during the first round of nominations.

Given the short nominations period, we used targeted promotions and emailing towards the specific caucuses that had seats open. Using the undergraduate emailing lists, we sent out individualized emails to each specific faculty to disseminate how many seats were open and the appropriate deadlines and dates. We also reached out to members of their respective societies to help spread the word. Additionally, by ordering a Digital + Print package from the Underground, we circulated posters around campus, and social media posts on Instagram, Facebook and Twitter.

We were unable to fill up all spots on the SRA, as there is still 1 Nursing seat open. We are content with the level of interest generated.
