Hello SRA (take three),

Student Advocacy Conference (SAC) is the Ontario Undergraduate Student Alliance's annual, week-long advocacy initiative. Based on the divisions of power between the different levels of government, the bulk of education falls under the provincial sector and presents a large opportunity for advocacy work. Advocacy week is a unique experience because it creates an opportunity for government officials to understand the reality of the challenges and barriers students face while pursuing their education. Conversation in these lobby meetings included suggestions for integrating student needs into housing and transit projects, supporting mental health services through a racial equity lens, enhancing on-campus food bank initiatives, and increasing government funding to universities.

Jazzlyn Abbott (AVP Provincial and Federal Affairs), 16 delegates and I met with various Members of Provincial Parliament, public servants and stakeholders to press for improvements to Ontario's post-secondary education system. Due to the cross-ministerial delegation of education, OUSA meets with politicians from a variety of different purviews & political parties. Jazzlyn and I had a very busy week where we met with;
