Yearplan Update

Since the last EB report, the Macademics team has been focused on the MSU Awards period as well the Winter Teaching Award nominations.

The team has fervently been working on promoting the MSU Awards period, which is open from January 15th – March 4th with regards to the 'Self Nominations', and from January 15th – February 26th with regards to 'Nominations for Others'. Likewise, ample promotions have been made for the Teaching Awards nominations period which had been open from February 5th and recently closed on February 19th. A total of 1429 nominations have been received; 888 for professors and 541 for teaching assistants. The team is now working on standardizing the nominations as well as sending the in-class evaluations to the top nominees.

The team is also currently working on final touches with regards to the Teaching Awards Ceremony which will take place on March 28th in CIBC Hall. The TAC team has informed AVTEK and the catering team of the date. The itinerary and individual exec and volunteer roles have also been finalized. Nearly all guest speakers which will be presenting awards have been confirmed. What we have left is to order thank-you gifts from the Underground in the next few days (awaiting PO approval) as well as to send the final award recipient names to Watson's Engravings.

Finally, the Research & Resources team is near finished the Resource Hub updates which we will be sending to the Underground soon to create both a digital and print (shortened brochure) version.

Events, Projects, & Activities

General Service Usage

As we currently have many exciting initiatives on the rise, the promotions committee has been working hard to engage the student-body through a variety of creative means including social media posts, reels, banners/posters as well as

handing out rave cards and sharing an announcement on A2L. The Macademics team also recently spent time at a table in MUSC, handing out rave cards and engaging with students regarding a variety of questions about Macademics and the Teaching Awards. The table was equipped with a variety of little prizes to attract the attention of students as well as have them remember the service in a high regard.

Project 1: Resource Hub Revamp (Ongoing)

The Research and Resources team is continuing the Resource Hub Revamp initiative. The information has been compiled and now the rest of the Macademics team has taken on making edits and improving the aspect of its accessibility. This is truly a grand initiative, and we are doing our best to ensure that it comes in the most accessible and easily understandable format so that edits to not need to be made in the near future.

Project 2: MSU Awards (Ongoing)

The MSU Student Recognition Award nominations are still open. The period of self-nominations is open from January 15th – March 14th and the nomination period for others is open from January 15th until February 26th. The promotional plan has made use of banners, posters, reels, social media graphics, and more. A hoodie giveaway poll was implemented throughout the Macademics social media to get some useful input from the student-body as well as to get them excited for the MSU Awards as well as the Teaching Awards! The winner has been announced and handed their hoodie.

Project 3: TAC Winter Nominations (Complete)

Teaching Awards nominations for the Winter semester were open from February 5th to 19th. We have received over 1400 nominations and will now collectively be working on standardizing them to provide an adequate level of time for the inclass evaluation period. The responses are projected to be reviewed by the middle of next week and will be followed by the decision regarding final Teaching Awards winners. A hoodie giveaway poll was implemented throughout the Macademics social media to get some useful input from the student-body as well as to get them excited for the MSU Awards as well as the Teaching Awards! The winner has been announced and handed their hoodie.

Outreach & Promotions

Summary

February has consisted of a very busy time for Macademics, with two of the largest campaigns taking place. With the help of the Underground, the promotions team has put together beautiful graphics, banners, and rave cards for both MSU Awards and TAC Winter Nominations. 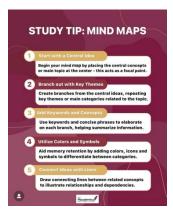
