



## Bylaw 10/A – Delegate Selection

### 1. Purpose

- 1.1 To ensure the appropriate procedures are followed in the selection of delegates to represent the McMaster Students Union at conferences.

### 2. Delegates

- 2.1 The Chief delegate to the conference shall be responsible for submitting a written report to the SRA within ten (10) days of closing of the conference;
- 2.2 The Chief delegate shall be, whenever possible, the Chair or the appropriate MSU committee or manager of an operation / department. In the event that the Chair or manager is unable to attend, the following order shall normally be used in the selection of the Chief delegate:
  - 2.2.1 The President;
  - 2.2.2 The Vice-President (Administration);
  - 2.2.3 An SRA member or committee member chosen by the appropriate supervisor or Commissioner and ratified by the SRA;
  - 2.2.4 The remainder of the conference delegates shall be chosen by the Chief delegate and ratified by the SRA.

### 3. Selection Criteria

- 3.1 Delegate selection shall be based upon, but not limited to, the following qualifications:
  - 3.1.1 Experience with the organization / committee;
  - 3.1.2 Knowledge of MSU policy and practices;
  - 3.1.3 Current involvement in the organization / committee activities;
  - 3.1.4 Ability to attend for the duration of the conference;
  - 3.1.5 Potential for future involvement of the organization.
