





Uli's Stairs is a set of 305 steep wooden stairs hand-built by Uli Wiesel, a local resident who wanted to create a shortcut from the escarpment to the lower city in honour of his wife. These were the first stairs connecting the upper and lower city and still exist despite the half a million dollar metal staircase a block away.




Wentworth St S, Hamilton
