#### Yearplan Update

Since our last report, we've hit key milestones:

#### **Progress:**

#### Volunteer Hiring Process

- Launched executive hiring with HR support, reviewed applications.
- o Conducted 26 interviews over 2 days from 50+ applicants.
- Hired 14 volunteers: 5 RR, 5 TAC, 4 Promotions.

#### Team Information and Meetings

- Executives attending weekly meetings Thursday from 8-9pm
- Gathered essential info from volunteers and organized the first orientation meeting.
- Set up clear communication channels: SharePoint, group chat, Microsoft Teams.
- Subcommittees to begin biweekly meetings; I will attend the first few to offer support.

#### Resource Hub Launch and Engagement

- Successfully launched the Resource Hub with high engagement on videos and posts.
- Campus store giveaway (\$50) resulted in over 400 likes and boosted page traction with onset of volunteer hiring and resource hub launch.

#### Volunteer Training

- Conducted volunteer training in the committee room with cookie decorating and a slideshow.
- Recorded session and provided slides with a quiz for those who couldn't attend.

#### Blog Post and Reel

Released a blog post and accompanying reel to drive engagement.

#### Upcoming Plans

 TAC nominations planned for October 21-November 3 (after reading week).  Two tables booked in MUSC, all advertising materials purchased from Underground.

#### Ongoing: Team Information and Meetings

Executives are attending weekly meetings every Thursday from 8-9 PM. We gathered essential info from volunteers during our first orientation meeting. Clear communication channels are now set up using SharePoint, group chat, and Microsoft Teams. Subcommittees are set to begin biweekly meetings, and I'll attend the first few for support.

#### Ongoing: Resource Hub

The Resource Hub was successfully launched with significant engagement on videos and posts. The \$50 campus store giveaway boosted page traction, resulting in over 400 likes. However, some finishing touches are still needed. Our Research and Resources Executive is working with Underground to finalize the content and design to ensure it remains polished.

#### **Upcoming: TAC Nominations**

TAC nominations are scheduled for October 21-November 3, following reading week to maximize participation. Two tables have been booked in MUSC, and all advertising materials have been purchased from Underground. We have set up a meeting with comms to make a professional video to advertise the nominations this fall. We hope this will garner more engagement with the student body!

#### Completed: Volunteer Hiring

The volunteer hiring process was successfully completed. We conducted 26 interviews over two days, selected from 50+ applicants. As a result, we hired 14 volunteers—5 for RR, 5 for TAC, and 4 for Promotions.

#### Completed: Volunteer Training

Volunteer training was completed in the committee room, with a cookie decorating activity and a slideshow presentation. For those unable to attend, we

recorded the session and shared the slides along with a quiz to ensure their understanding.

#### Completed: Blog Post

We released a blog post last week, accompanied by a reel to further drive engagement. These will be released once a month (at least) moving forward.

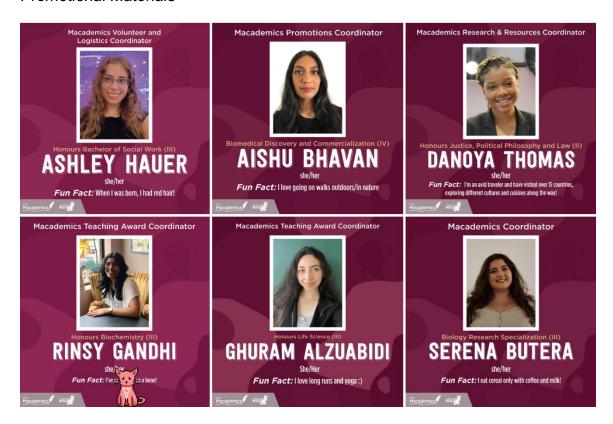
#### **Outreach & Promotions**

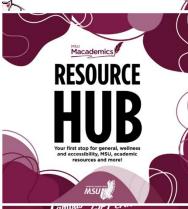

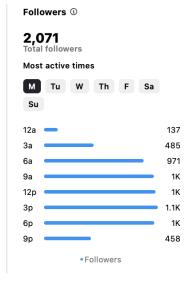
