The following changes are proposed to clarify and update the *Ontario Undergraduate Student Alliance (OUSA) Operating Policy* to more accurately reflect current practices and address concerns stemming from the vagueness of the policy.

5.2	The MSU shall send one (1) delegate per three thousand (3000) students, as well as the Vice-President (Education), to all meetings of OUSA's General Assembly (GA);	Add "voting"	To clarify the difference between voting and non-voting delegates.
5.2.1	One (1) delegate shall be the External Affairs Commissioner, or a	Change "External Affairs Commissioner" to "Associate Vice-President (Provincial & Federal Affairs)".	To reflect appropriate role titles.

5.2.3	The remaining delegates shall be selected from the MSU membership by the Vice-President (Education) and the External Affairs Commissioner;	Add “voting”. Change “External Affairs Commissioner” to “Associate Vice-President (Provincial & Federal Affairs)”. Add “through an application and interview process”.	To reflect appropriate role titles. To reflect current delegate selection processes.
5.2.4	N/A	Add “The MSU may send non-voting delegates at the discretion of the Vice-President (Education) & Vice-President (Finance);”	To clarify selection of non-voting delegates.
