At this conference, the three policy papers voted on were: Environmental Sustainability, Student Financial Aid, and Responding to the Blue-Ribbon Panel Report. Throughout the conference, delegates participated in breakout sessions discussing the papers, listened to presentations about student-led environmental sustainability & student financial aid projects, networked with other student unions, and attended plenary where the three papers were officially voted on.
