SRA Symposium Update

Following discussions with Dr. Da Silva and Luca (former MSS president), we recognized that launching a new symposium might duplicate existing events and not maximize SRA special project funds. Instead, we plan to collaborate with MSU clubs or the MSS on established symposiums, ensuring our mission aligns with ongoing efforts. Additionally, we're exploring ideas like featuring undergraduate researchers on our social media and providing a research-specific helpline during office hours, offering guidance on funding, contacting PIs, and navigating the research landscape.

iSci Society x SRA Collaboration

As part of connecting to more science students, we are reaching out to program societies that require support with promotions and/or fundraising. The iSci Society runs an annual fundraiser every year for their graduating students, and they have asked the SRA to help promote their content and organize some logistics with setting up a booth. We will be assisting them in this manner, with no costs incurred.
